### 11 – 17 MAY 2026 - NATIONAL FAMILIES WEEK

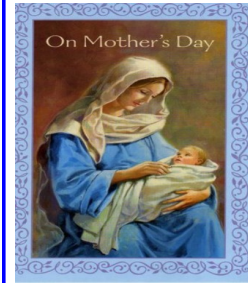

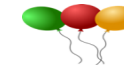

### NATIONAL COUNT OF CHURCH ATTENDANCE



The **'National Count of Church Attendance'** is currently being conducted throughout Australia in all Dioceses and Parishes. This is the second weekend of the **Count**. In addition to recording the number of people attending Church services, next weekend, (16/17 May), a split between the number of females and males will also be recorded, and in the fourth weekend (23/24 May), a split will be conducted of age cohorts.

The Count is always held the same year the Australian Bureau of Census and Statistics conducts the Australian Census (this year to be held 11 August 2026). Parishioners co-operation, and their appreciation of the process that needs to be followed over these weekends, will be greatly appreciated.
